DISCUSSION: Direction of district

Superintendent Archuleta shared that she is working on the reopening of the A+ Grill at Robertson for the 2019-2020 school year ensuring that it meets the necessary requirements. The life skills classroom at Robertson will also be redone during the summer. Superintendent Archuleta also reviewed other projects

throughout the district including phase 2 of Los Niños Elementary; Robertson/Memorial Middle School campus improvements: campus fencing and site security, emergency notification system, interior door replacement; and site fencing, security camera, exterior site lighting and painting at Mike Mateo Sena.

- a. Building utility costs Superintendent Archuleta reviewed the utility costs of the each school site and discussed the monthly utility amounts for each of the schools currently not occupied. Board Member Lovato Pacheco inquired as to the insurance amount for each school not occupied and if there was a difference to those currently occupied by students and staff.
- **b. Instructional Materials** Superintendent Archuleta reviewed the upcoming Science curriculum adoption material information and cost with the board. Stated that the district was compiling the orders for all areas and orders would be placed for materials by the first week of July.
