

## 2024 NMCEL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. The applicant must be academically strong with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher.
- 2. The applicant should be a well-rounded student participating in diversified activities in both school and community.
- 3. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a public high school in the state of New Mexico, without regard to race, ethnicity, or gender.
- 4. Applications must be mailed to Bobbie Gutierrez, NMCEL Scholarship Committee Chair (bj.gutierrez@nmreca.org) and cc to: Belinda Sanchez at NMCEL (belinda@nmcel.org) no later than Friday, April 12, 2024.
- 5. The selection committee will consist of three-five members from the NMCEL/NMSSA Executive Boards.
- 6. The committee shall be facilitated by the NMCEL Board Member Scholarship Committee Chair,
- 7. The applicants will be rated on the Application Form, References, and Written Essay. The application form services as the Cover Page for the packet.
- 8. The Scholarship Selection Committee will interview the top five finalists on Friday, May 3, 2024 via ZOOM.
- 9. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified in writing no later than **Friday**, **May** 10, 2024. All other applicants will be notified by mail, not later than **Friday**, **May** 17, 2024.
- 10. The recipients must be enrolled as a full-time student in a college or university of their choice, in the fall of the school year after graduation.
- 11. Three scholarships in the amount of \$3,000.00 will be awarded to the successful applicants at the annual Awards Luncheon at the NMCEL Conference the week of July 15, 2024. Embassy Suites Hotel, Albuquerque, NM.
- 12. The scholarship will be payable to the students in three payments, one for the Fall Semester, Spring Semester, and one the following Fall Semester, after proof of enrollment is submitted to the NMCEL office for the second Fall Semester.
- 13. The scholarship will be forfeited if the student does not begin college or university classes during the fall semester after graduation or leaves after the first semester.



## New Mexico Coalition of Educational Leaders 2024 Scholarship Award Criteria

The New Mexico Coalition of Educational Leaders will award three \$3,000 scholarships to New Mexico high school seniors who will be entering a college or university.

## CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION AND SELECTION CANDIDATES

- 1. Candidate must be a graduating senior from any public high school in the state of New Mexico.
- 2. Candidates must have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better for consideration.
- 3. Preference will be given to those entering the field of education (Teacher, Counselor, Social Worker, School Business Official, etc.).
- 4. Interviews with each of the top five candidates will be conducted by the Selection Committee in May.

## APPLICATION PROCESS: Submit the following completed documents:

- 1. The Scholarship Application Form (signed by High School Official and Principal)
- 2. Two letters of recommendation from teachers/and or school administrators.
- 3. A typed 300–400-word essay outlining the candidate's reasons for entering the field of education.
- 4. Official High School Transcript
- 5. Scanned Application Packet of documents if submitting electronically.
